I, SUSANNE R. MURRAY, a resident of Maricopa County, Arizona, being not unmindful of the uncertainties of life, and being desirous of disposing of my property at my death, do hereby make, publish, and declare this my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT in manner and form following, hereby revoking all previous Wills or Codicils to Wills by me made:

FIRST: I declare that I am a widow and that I have one (1) child named ANN MURRAY CHAPMAN. I further declare that all my property is my own separate property.

SECOND: I make the following specific devises and bequests of the following specific items, provided that the person shall survive me:

- (a) I give, devise and bequeath to my daughter, ANN MURRAY CHAPMAN, my antique furniture and antique books for use by her during her life-time, and upon her decease then the same shall go to her children in equal shares. In this instrument children shall include adopted children. I leave to my Executors the decision as to what shall be classified as antique furniture and books, and their decision shall be final and conclusive upon all persons.
- (b) All of the rest of my tangible personal property such as clothing, furs, jewelry, personal effects, books, household furnishings and equipment, automobiles, articles of household or personal use or

adornment, not otherwise herein bequeathed, to my daughter, ANN MURRAY CHAPMAN.

- (c) To my friend, MRS. MARION R. BOWES, my diamond bracelet and cash in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).
- (d) To my daughter's former nurse, INEZ NELSON, of St. Paul, Minnesota, the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).
- (e) To my friend, MRS. GLORIA MACINNES, of Chicago, Illinois, the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).
- (f) To CHRIST CHURCH, of Winnetka, Illinois, the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).
- (g) To EVANSTON HOSPITAL ASSOCIATION, Evanston, Illinois, the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).
- (h) To my friend, GRACE KAUFMANN, of Phoenix, Arizona, the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).
- (i) I am not unmindful of my housekeeper, LOUISE DUNNING; however, I have made provisions for her under the terms of a trust agreement between myself as Settlor and THE NORTHERN TRUST COMPANY, as Trustee, and, therefore, leave her nothing under this Will.

THIRD: I give to my daughter, ANN MURRAY CHAPMAN, if she survives me, the following:

- (a) All interest, except any interest in my residence presently located at 5629 East Rockridge Road, Phoenix, Arizona, I may have at the time of my death in real estate in Maricopa County, Arizona.
- (b) All interest I may have at the time of my death in real estate, including surface rights and minerals, in Louisiana, and also all interest in any oil, gas, or mineral property, interest, or payment, real or personal, in such state.

- (c) All interest I may have at the time of my death in real estate, including surface rights and minerals, in Mississippi, and also all interest in any oil, gas, or mineral property, interest, or payment, real or personal, in such state.
- (d) All interest which I may have at the time of my death in the partnership of QUARTER CIRCLE W CATTLE COMPANY, conducting a real estate investment business in Arizona, or in any partnership, proprietorship, or corporation, that may succeed to its business, except that the foregoing bequest shall not include any partnership or proprietorship income accrued or on hand but undistributed at the time of my death.

FOURTH: All the residue of my estate and property, real and personal, wherever situated, including all lapsed legacies, but expressly excluding any property over which I may now or hereafter have a power of appointment, I give to the then acting Trustee under that certain Agreement made and executed by me on May 1, 1967, before the execution of this Will, with THE NORTHERN TRUST COMPANY, an Illinois corporation, of Chicago, Illinois, as Trustee (designated as Trust Number 33308), to be added to the Trust Estate created under said Agreement and held, administered and disposed of in accordance with all the provisions of said Agreement, including any amendments or modifications thereof made at any time before or after the date of this Will.

FIFTH: (a) I nominate, constitute and appoint my attorney, T. W. SHUMWAY, and the VALLEY NATIONAL BANK, Phoenix, Arizona, a national banking association, as CO-EXECUTORS of this my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT. In the event that my attorney, T. W. SHUMWAY, should be unable or unwilling to act in such capacity, then

the VALLEY NATIONAL BANK, Phoenix, Arizona, shall act as sole EXECUTOR. I further declare that neither of my Co-Executors shall be required to give any bond or security for the faithful performance of their duties.

(b) The Executors shall have the following additional rights and powers with respect to any oil, gas or mineral properties or interests that may be held or acquired by the Executors hereunder:

(i) To continue to hold, manage, control and operate any oil, gas or mineral property or interest, real or personal, the right, title or interest in which has been acquired pursuant to any agreement, assignment, contract, deed, grant lease payment, royalty agreement, overriding royalty agreement, farmout or, pursuant to any chose in action of any kind relating to the development, drilling, mining, operating or production of oil, gas or minerals or the sale or recovery thereof.

(ii) To develop, drill (offset or otherwise), explore, mine and operate all or any part of any estate property for the development, production, recovery and sale of oil, gas or other valuable minerals, or to sell any right or interest therein for the aforesaid purposes; to pool or unitize all or any part of such properties with any other property, and to enter into the installation and operation of storage facilities, absorption plants and repressuring plant or any other facilities that may be deemed advisable by the Executors.

(iii) To execute oil, gas or mineral leases for any term (even though such term commences in the future or extends beyond the duration of this estate), agreements, assignments, contracts, deeds, grants or such other instruments or documents, as the Executors deem advisable and appropriate.

(iv) All net amounts received by the Executors from the sale of oil, gas or other minerals taken from property owned or leased by the Executors of the estate or received by the Executors as consideration for the permanent severance of oil, gas or other minerals taken from such property (whether as a royalty, bonus or other type of payment) shall, notwithstanding anything in this instrument to the contrary, be apportioned to principal and income of the estate as follows: Such percentage thereof as the Executors determine to be deducted for depletion under the laws of the Internal Revenue Code for Federal Income Tax purposes in force and effect from time to time when such payments are received shall be a reserve for depletion and added to principal and the balance shall be considered as income, or in the event at any time the Internal Revenue Code shall not provide for such deduction for depletion, then twenty-five per cent (25%) of the net amounts so received each year shall be a reserve for depletion and added to principal and the balance thereof shall be considered as income.




