Mr. Myrick is currently building a home in the County. Unfortunately, he is outside of Bear Creek's certificated area which means Mr. Myrick may not be served water directly from that agency.

Mr. Myrick has two options: 1) Drill a well, or 2) Install a line across the County's Right of Way (R.O.W.) to Bear Creek's area for service.

Therefore, it is recommended that Mr. Myrick be given permission to construct a waterline to the County's and Bear Creek's standards across the R.O.W., and be required to release the County from any future liability associated with said line.
