

Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting Quick Notes: April 6, 2026

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, “the Board,” was advised by Butler Snow Law Firm, the County’s federal government lobbyists, that the County has been the recipient of approximately \$25m during the last five fiscal years.
- The County approved issuing \$15m in bonds for the continuation of the Madison County Improvement Plan. The remainder of the plan involves widening Catlett Rd., Stribling Rd., Weisenberger Rd., West County Line Rd., Yandell Rd, and others.
- At the request of Supervisor Trey Baxter, the Board appointed Chris Hinkle to the Madison County Library Board.
- Strategic Marketing Group, the County’s public relations firm, announced that the County’s Facebook page now has more than 15,000 followers with more than 80 percent residing in Madison County.
- At the request of Supervisor Paul Griffin, the Board appointed Claurice Buckley to the Valley View Fire District.
- The Board approved Final Plats for the Lakes at Stapleton, the White Oaks Farms, Phase II.
- The Board approved preliminary plats for Lost Rabbit Phase V and Lost Rabbit Phase VI.
- The Board approved hiring Key Construction, the lowest bidder, to complete the North Old Canton Road/Bridges Replacement Project. Following the bridge repair, the County will overlay a significant portion of North Old Canton beginning at Yandell going North.
