

Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting Quick Notes: July 6, 2026

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, “the Board,” welcomed Mississippi Transportation Commissioner Willie Simmons and a representative from Capitol Resources (the County’s State Lobbying Firm) to discuss the \$150m appropriated by the Mississippi State Legislature for widening a portion of I-55 in Madison County. In addition, they reported that \$2m was appropriated for work to be done on Weisenberger Road and Gluckstadt Road. **We will place a video of the presentation onto our Facebook page.**
- The Board acknowledged the 2026 Real and Personal Tax Rolls, as presented by Madison County Tax Assessor Norman Cannady. **We will place a video of his presentation onto our Facebook page.**
- The Board received a presentation from the Madison County Economic Development Authority regarding Amazon Web Services (AWS) revenue projections. **We will place a video of the presentation onto our Facebook page.**
- The Board approved tax exemptions for specific parcels on behalf of Goodwill Industries of Mississippi, Livingston Fellowship, and Holy Trinity Anglican Church.
- The Board approved the appointment of Ann Johnson as the interim director of the County’s Veterans Service Office beginning July 15th. Madison County is home to more than 6,000 Veterans.
- The County entered into Interlocal Agreements with Canton and Flora to complete Calhoun Station.
- The County entered into an Interlocal Agreement with Flora to pave two roads and to be reimbursed up to \$72,000.
- The Board awarded a bid to Great Southern Recreation for the playground and pavilion at Rogers Park.
