

Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting Quick Notes: July 20, 2026

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, “the Board,” received a quarterly update from engineers working on the following capacity improvement projects in Madison County:
 - Calhoun Station Parkway (Stantec)
 - Stribling Road from Highway 463 to Dewees Road (Garver Engineering)
 - Stribling Road from Dewees Road to Catlett Road (Michael Baker Engineering)
 - Weisenberger Road (Neel-Schaffer Engineering)
 - Yandell Road from Highway 51 to Smith Carr Road (Waggoner Engineering)
 - Yandell Road from Smith Carr Road to North Old Canton Road (Waggoner Engineering)
 - Intersection of North Old Canton Road and Yandell Road (Benchmark Engineering)
 - South Wheatley Street Reconstruction and Sidewalk improvements (Benchmark Engineering)
 - Yandell Road from North Old Canton Road to Bainbridge Crossing (Pickering Engineering)
 - Yandell Road from Bainbridge Crossing to Highway 43 (Pickering Engineering)

- The Board received a quarterly update from Pafford Ambulance Service:
 - They responded to 2,500 calls.
 - 10:45 was the average response time.
 - They are placing an ambulance in Gluckstadt.
- The Board held a public hearing on the Urban Renewal Plan for the proposed Madison County Conference Center. Having heard no objections, the Board approved the Urban Renewal Plan and engaged professionals to begin borrowing the funds for construction.

- On behalf of the Valley View Fire Department, the Board increased the millage rate by 2 points.
- The Board hired Ann Johnson as the Director of the Madison County Veterans Service office.
- At the request of the Election Commission, the Board hired Franky J's moving company to transport election equipment safely and securely to and from the polls in November.
- The Board approved the final plat for Glendale Farms, Phase 3. The development is 68 lots on approximately 27.74 acres.
- The Board approved the final plat of Glenwild, Part Seven. The development is 73 lots on approximately 25.7574 acres.
