

Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting Quick Notes: August 17, 2026

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, “the Board,” along with the State Director of the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), announced that Madison County has been approved for flood mitigation work on and around Bear Creek. This flood mitigation effort is valued at \$26m and will help reduce repeated flooding in the Canton area.

A media release will be published on our Facebook page, Madison County MS Government outlining the details of the project.

- The board approved the low bid for work to be done on Pear Orchard Road from AJ Construction, Inc in the amount of \$278,569.55.
- The Board ratified a Declaration of Emergency for the work being done on Finney Road Bridge. The Bridge is scheduled to open this upcoming Friday.
- The Board approved scheduling Household Hazardous Waste Day for October 3 at Madison Central High School. We will post more details as we get closer to the date of the event.

The Madison County Board of Supervisors will meet next on September 8, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. in the Administrative Building in Canton.

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
