

Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting Quick Notes: November 6, 2023

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, “the Board,” acknowledged Region 8 Mental Health’s Annual Report. It was also confirmed that an additional 16-bed facility will likely be finished in February to accommodate additional patients from Madison and Rankin counties.
- At the request of Supervisor Paul Griffin, the Board reappointed Calvin Garrett to the Madison County Mega Site Alliance Fire District Board.
- The Board acknowledged proposed covenants for Woodgate subdivision. The covenants, which will be enforced by the homeowners’ association (HOA), includes a provision prohibiting rental or lease-to own-homes unless approved by a 60% vote of the HOA.
- The Board voted to pay the City of Canton \$88,882.02 owed to the city by the Madison County Tax Collector’s Office from the last three fiscal years. In addition, the Board requested an Attorney General’s Opinion to determine if the Tax Collector can pay for errors made in years beyond the three-year statute of limitations.
- The Board approved the final plat of Cripple Creek Farms. The development contains 8 lots on 31.93 acres.
- The Board approved the final plat of Robinson Springs Estates. The development contains 2 lots on 32.59 acres.
- The Board approved the final plat of Springwood, Phase 2. The development contains 12 lots on 158.26 acres.
- The Board approved the preliminary plat for The Meadowlands at Stout Farms, Part 4.
- The Board approved the preliminary plat for Woodscape of Oakfield, Phase 5.

The Madison County Board of Supervisors will meet next on November 20, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. in the Administrative Building in Canton.

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
