- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, "the Board," announced more than 1,100 homes and businesses will have access to internet service by the end of the month as part of the County's broadband project.
- The Board congratulated Sheriff Randy Tucker for being elected as the President of the Mississippi Sheriffs' Association.
- The Board acknowledged the organizational chart for the Madison County Justice Court.
- The Board approved the final plat for Battmore Estates. The development is 5 lots on approximately 128.15 acres.
- Regarding the Pear Orchard Maintenance Project, the Board approved allowing AJ Construction, Inc. to subcontract work to the following subcontractors:

- The Board passed a Resolution in support of a "Safe Streets for All" Grant Application for work to be done at the intersection of US 51 at Yandell Road/Weisenberger Road. This project is estimated at \$4.8m with \$1.15m contributed by the County.
