## MADISON COUNTY GENERAL ELECTION

Madison County will be conducting its' 2024 Presidential General Election on Tuesday, November 5, 2024 from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M. For your convenience, the Circuit Clerk's office will be open from 8:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. Monday through Friday for anyone that needs to vote absentee. **Absentee voting will begin September 23, 2024**.

Following are some additional hours the Circuit Clerk's office will be open and some important deadline dates:

Saturday, October 5th, 2024 8:00 A.M. – 12:00 Noon

**Monday, October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024** – deadline to register to vote in the November 5, 2024 Presidential General Election – must register in person by 5:00 p.m. or have registration postmarked by this date

**Saturday, October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2024** 8:00 A.M. – 12:00 Noon – this is also the deadline date for a completed FPCA from a UOCAVA voter.

Saturday, November 2nd, 2024 8:00 A.M. – 12:00 Noon (deadline to absentee vote)

ABSENTEE BALLOTS THAT ARE TO BE RETURNED BY MAIL <u>MUST</u> BE POSTMARKED ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 5, 2024 AND RECEIVED BY THE CIRCUIT CLERK'S OFFICE BY NOVEMBER 13, 2024 AT 5:00 P.M.
